The Federation of the Cultivar Nation is a fledgling, cultured, nomadic group of 10 tribes. They are renowned for their barren, inhospitable landscape, avowedly heterosexual populace, and compulsory military service. They have a Matriarchal family social system in which women hold the primary power positions in roles of family authority. The common belief in the cultivar culture is that the mother is the most important person in society. Women rule the domestic realm of family life. In

Cultivar Nationian society, women hold a unique role believed to be associated with the earth's power to create life. The hard-working, devout population of 6 million Cultivar Nationians have full civil rights; they enjoy the freedom to spend their money however they like, to a point, and participate in free and open elections every two years.

The relatively small government prioritizes Spirituality, with Welfare, Defense, and Law & Order also on the agenda, while Industry and Environment receive no government funds. The average income tax rate is 9.0%.

The Cultivar Nationian economy, worth 352 billion CANNs a year, is led by the Hemp Basket Weaving industry, with significant contributions from Hemp & Cannabis Exports, Precious Metals Minings, Hydrogen Automobile Manufacturing, Hydrogen Production, CBD Home Delivery, and CBD Exports.

The average income of a Cultivar Nationian is 58,795 CANNs, with the wealthiest citizens earning 5.3 times as much as the poorest.

Citizens receive notices of their civic duties along with their parking tickets, voting is voluntary, punitive tariffs protect local industry, and cannabis hair stylists are among those who are in demand. Crime, especially youth-related, is almost non-existent.

Every Cultivar family's civic duty is to own guns and support their local militia to protect their family and the Cultivar Nation. The Cultivar Nationian has inherent individual rights endowed by the Creator; such rights include property rights, Tribal Land Mineral Rights, and the right to petition the government for a redress of grievances, such as the right to make a complaint to or seek the assistance of, one's elected representatives, without fear of punishment or reprisals.

The Cultivar Nation's national animal is the EAGLE, which they protect from the brink of extinction due to the urbanization of other non-cultivar tribes.

The Cultivar Nation Government - The ten tribes have an elaborate political system. It includes a bicameral (two-house) legislature. Twenty legislators, ten men and ten women elected to the Cultivar Nationians from all ten Cultivar Tribes elect each Legislator for the Upper House and serve only one term in office. The individual tribe elects the two legislators, one man and one woman of the Lower House Nationians, and they do two consecutive terms if re-elected or two non-consecutive terms. All legislators receive no salary for their service to the Cultivar Nation, and their direct families and businesses are exempt from paying the 9% taxes for the duration of their legislative service.

Both Houses elect a leader for the Term of the legislative session. The elected leader of the Upper House takes the Role of the president of the Federation of the Cultivar Nation, and the elected leader of the Lower House takes the role of the Vice President of the Cultivar Nation.

The President holds emergency powers in the event of a war of aggression against the Cultivar Nation. And the vice president represents both houses' consent to declare war on other nations outside the homeland.

The Cultivar Nation Education - In a gynocentric family structure, early childhood education is focused primarily on the family and family elders. Each Cultivar Tribe community has set up a four-tier education system for Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, and Ancient Classics. Tier one consists of ages five to ten; in this tier, civics and traditions are required along with early STEM. Tier two consists of ages ten to fourteen with advanced civics and an intermediary STEM program. Tier

three is from age fourteen to eighteen, including an advanced STEM program, On Job Training for specialized areas, and continuation of Cultivar civics and traditions. The last tier, number four, is based on Advance Education in universities and other higher learning institutions that are offered for free for everyone. Education drives the Cultivar Nations' industry. Each Higher Education institution is funded by industries in the economy that are vested in producing the best possible educational value for the industry. For example, the agricultural sector will support agricultural higher learning and so forth.

The Cultivar Nation Banking - is a unique banking system; because of the evolution of blockchain technologies, each Cultivar Nationian is a small decentralized micro bank, either as a daily or an individual that lends their money to a Banking House. The Upper and Lower House of Legislators define the type of money the Cultivar tribe will create and issues a total supply based on the asset wealth of each Tribe. These new monies are Blockchain driven and have a deflationary component.

This Banking House or Exchange is one of many Decentralized Autonomous Organizations used by industry to borrow funds for their industry needs. The funds are lent to the Industry by a consensus of cultivar nationians, the micro bank depositors. They vote to lend or reject this funding. These funds are staked in the loan of that specific industry, and they see a fair return on their money based on the terms of the loan. The only way to create new blockchain money is by exchanging it for labor or physical assets. All physical assets have an inherent value that the owner of that asset can withdraw up to 70% of its value and place the asset as collateral from the Governing Exchange for a minimal rate of 0.007% plus the exchange fee. When that money is borrowed again, the asset is repaid; every repayment is *burned* to reduce the supply. If the asset is forfeited due to lack of payment, it is placed on a blockchain on auction. The money from the auction is burned¹ since the need to reduce the blockchain money supply is the key goal, not a profit.

The Cultivar Nation Environment - The Cultivars are skilled agrarians; not only do they produce Hemp and Cannabis, but their stewardship of the forests makes them second to none. Their spruce and pine seedling are one of the best in the world. Their abundant supply of fertilizer, a significant byproduct of their hydrogen product, makes them the largest supplier of tree seedlings for reforestation and desert reclamation. Their byproduct of Carbon Dioxide is sequestered into solid form and sold to Greenhouses worldwide for food production in areas that until today were barren land.

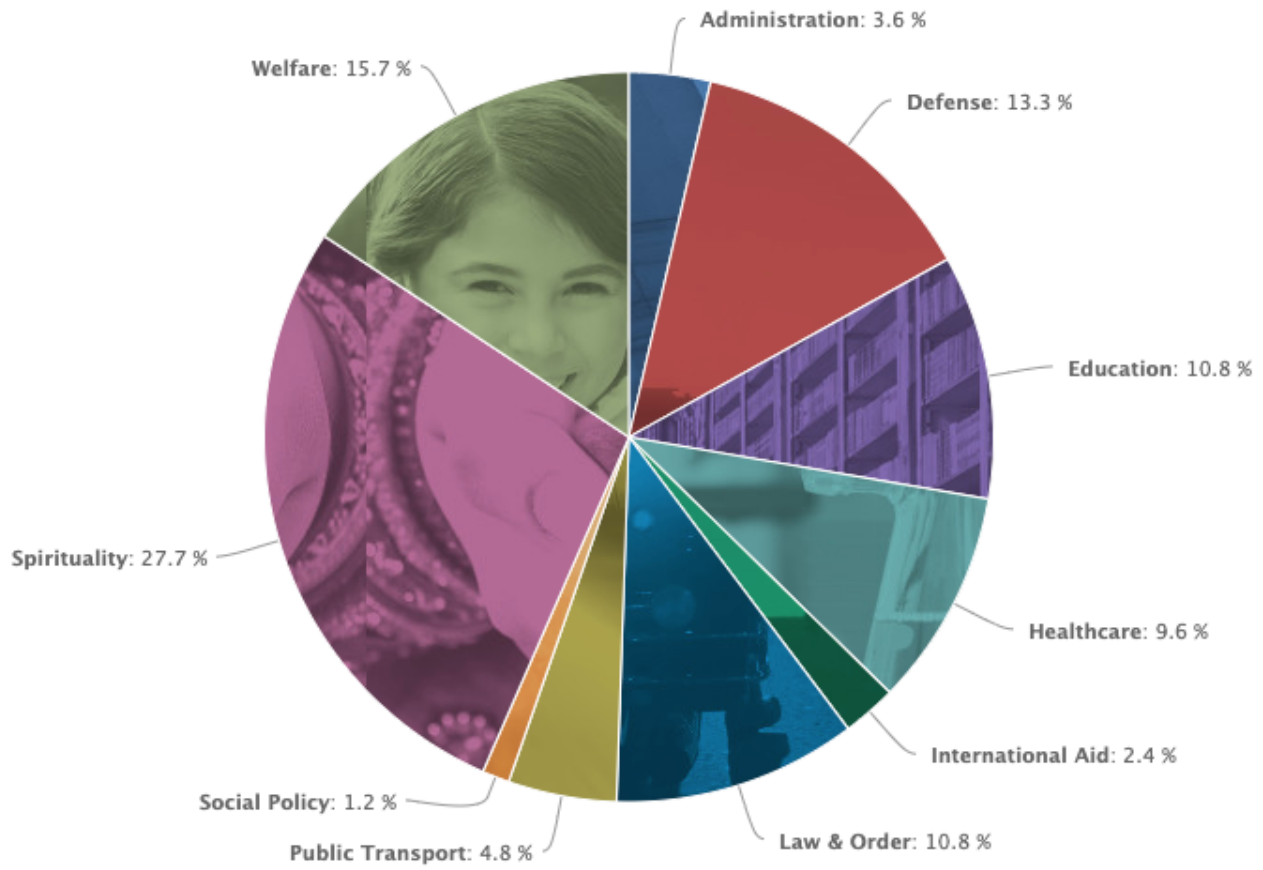
